Housing Assignment

Waiting List

- Vacant dwellings are assigned according to a waiting list system administered by the housing associations.
- Everyone can sign up (no income criteria).

Municipal Housing Assignment

The municipal board has the right to dispose of up to 25 percent of the general family dwellings in the municipality for social housing needs.

Flexible Assignment (Municipal Agreement)

The municipality and the housing organization can agree on a housing assignment plan according to special criteria. E.g., give priority to commuters with employment in the municipality or to young students.
